DESCRIPTION

The Burlington County Library System (BCLS) seeks a Graphic Designer & Multimedia Specialist to support the library's marketing and communications efforts by creating compelling visual materials that engage the community and promote library services, events, and other offerings. As part of the marketing team this role involves working closely with departments to design both print and digital assets that communicate effectively across a variety of platforms. Responsibilities include:

- Design a wide range of marketing materials such as flyers, posters, signage, advertisements, and other high-quality visuals.
- Capture, edit, and retouch professional-quality photographs of library programs, services, and events.
- Produce, edit, and compile videos showcasing library initiatives and programs.
- Adapt photos, videos, and designs for various mediums, such as social media, email newsletters, the library website, and other platforms as needed.
- Ensure visual consistency with the library's brand guidelines across all platforms.
- Collaborate with library staff to ensure visual content aligns with library branding and messaging.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- Strong conceptual design skills, including typography and layout expertise.
- Proficiency in Adobe Creative Suite (Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Acrobat, etc.).
